

ACUE-Certified Faculty Experience Transformational Reduction in DFW Rates at Florida Atlantic University



Florida Atlantic University (FAU) is a public Hispanic-Serving Institution (HSI) in southeast Florida, serving over 30,000 students across six campuses. The main campus of this research-focused university is located in Boca Raton, Florida.

The Challenge

FAU is committed to preparing students to lead in an ever-changing global environment. Seeking to enhance student outcomes in its general education courses and better prepare students for an evolving workforce, leaders made it a strategic priority to invest in faculty development to ensure evidence-based teaching and learning.

The Solution

FAU began a partnership with ACUE in 2019, which expanded in 2021 to offer ACUE Pathway courses leading to the Effective Teaching Certification. A study found that students taught by ACUE-certified faculty achieved significantly stronger academic outcomes, including a remarkable decrease in Ds, Fs, and Withdrawal (DFW) rates. Building on these results, FAU adopted ACUE Complete in order to scale ACUE's offerings and further strengthen teaching and learning.

THE RESULTS

39%

Fewer Ds, Fs, and Withdrawals

Students taught by ACUE-certified faculty received 39% fewer Ds, Fs, or Withdrawals.

10%

Higher Grades in General Ed Courses

Students in general education courses taught by ACUE faculty earned 10% higher grades.

2.5%

Higher Course Completion Among Hispanic/Latino Students

Course completion among students taught by ACUE faculty increased 2% overall and 2.5% among Hispanic/Latino students.


48% of instructional staff participated in ACUE pathway courses and nearly 20% have earned the certification.







Confidence using active learning techniques in large classes


